- 2. You should maintain a <u>week-wise work record</u> in the log book to summarize the work done in the office, site visits, meetings with clients, and agencies, and interaction with principal architects.

INTERNSHIP WORK REPORT - Here are a few guidelines for the compilation of your internship Work Report. I have attached a template in PPT format, for you to be able to keep on adding your work of internship and also as a guide for you to understand how the portfolio is to be compiled.

Particulars and pointers for the 'Internship Portfolio (report & drawings): All this is mentioned and formatted in the Template PPT as well.

- Cover page with title 'Internship report', your name, Roll no., Class, batch and the name of the office you worked in. All this is done in the template.
- Index including all the contents of your portfolio

- Start with your **intent for the internship** and why you wanted to do the internship in that particular office, what did you want to learn, what were your expectations, etc.
- Write about the type of office you worked in, in terms of scale, type of projects, type of design approach, etc.
- Talk about your office ambiance and colleagues.
- Write down in detail, the type of work and the responsibilities given to you in office.
- Write down in detail the **site visit reports**, which comprises site visit photos, sketches, intent of site visit, your leanings, etc.
- If you went out of town for any work or generally on weekends, apart from your work to experience some place, please include the study of the same in your report.
- Include the drawings, sketches, details, etc. that you did in the office.
- All the official drawings should have the stamp of the office and the signature of the architect on the same.
- Conclude your report with an **epilogue** on, how this transition from academics to first taste of professional work was for you? What were our leanings, how this helped you in changing as a person, what bridges and gaps you found between the academic work and actual professional practice.
- This compilation of reports and drawings need to be spiral bound and submitted.
- Go through the template PPT properly.
- Edit only that is editable (mentioned in green color- you can change the font style and color- keep the font size as mentioned.).
- To add extra pages with the same template, you will get a template option in the layout.
