
1. Solar Decathlon India





Competition requirements



Brief about design-

- A standalone multi-storied residential building is to be designed on plot size- 68m x 48m in such a way that 4/3/2 flats are to be designed on each floor.
- The project location would be in Mumbai with FSI as-2.
- North is upright
- Minimum setback of 6m from the front side and 3m from all other sides.
- Assume 1 road and site surroundings.

Parameters to assess design entries-

- Solar passive design measures (orientation, window to wall ratio, design of shading devices)
- Choice of materials for building envelope.
- Overall understanding of code.

Submission should have following details in presentation (ppt format)

- Master plan
- Floor plans
- Elevations and Sections
- Cross section indicating fenestration design
- Indicative calculations for ENS compliance-

WFR for any 1 typical dwelling unit, WWR and RETV for the West façade only AND U-value calculations for the top roof.

Results will be declared in November 2020

Terms and conditions

- Design team should have minimum 1 faculty as mentor.
- Minimum 1 entry from each institute/college is mandatory.

15. FUTURE OFFICE - Rethinking Office Spaces 1st Place



20. Mars Calling- Honourable mention


(International level Design Competition)







25. Streets for People Challenge-Pimpri Chinchwad, **shortlisted entry top 11** (National level Design Competition)






















29. The Little big Loo
