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

Congratulations to all the Participating Institutions (PIs) selected under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, a flagship program of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) Government of India through a challenge mode application. The Mission of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to enable participating higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. - Gender: The Trust is gender neutral. The Terms and Conditions of the Grant refer to the male gender to avoid inelegance of construction and apply equally to the female gender.


