

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGES BETWEEN SATISH MISAL EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION'S BRICK GROUP OF INSTITUTES AND THOMAS JEFFERSON UNIVERSITY

PREAMBLE

Satish Misal Educational Foundation's Brick Group of Institutes (Pune, India) ("Brick") and Thomas Jefferson University (Philadelphia, PA, USA) ("Jefferson") recognize the value of international cooperation and seek to expand scholarly ties, facilitate academic cooperation, and promote mutual understanding between Brick and Jefferson. Brick and Jefferson are also hereinafter referred to singly as university or party and collectively as universities or parties.

Through this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), both parties agree to explore an academic and scientific cellaboration between Brick and Jefferson based on the principles of mutual equality and the reciprocity of benefits. This MOU establishes guidelines for possible collaboration between the parties, but is not intended to create any specific commitment or obligation of either party to the other. The specific terms and conditions of each collaboration will be determined in a separate program agreement as defined in Section 5 below.

1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 "Home University" means the university sending staff or students to the Host University.
- 1.2 "Host University" means the university accepting the staff or students from the Home University.
- 1.3 "Inviting University" means the university requesting a staff or student to participate in a cultural exchange program.

2. STAFF EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

2.1 Reciprocal Exchange of Academic Staff/Staff Program

The two parties may nominate their academic staff to participate in an exchange for the purpose of studying or lecturing in the other university on a reciprocal basis. The visiting academic staff participant (each, an "Exchange Visitor") shall be subject to all applicable laws of the host country, including but not limited to immigration laws, and subject to approval by the Host University. The period of exchange will normally be one or two semesters. For academic exchanges, it is anticipated that the Home University will maintain its Exchange Visitor on full salary during the period of the exchange. The Host University will provide a university

Except for Sections 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 15, 16 and 19, this MOU is not legally binding on the parties.

17. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

If any misunderstandings arise during the term of this MOU, the parties will seek to resolve the matter by discussion between them.

18. REPUTATION

Notwithstanding other clauses in this MOU, the parties will use their best endeavors not to carry out any action that is likely to damage the reputation of the other.

19. ENGLISH

This MOU has been made in English in two identical copies for signature by the parties. Notwithstanding any versions of this MOU which may exist in languages other than English, Jefferson shall be bound only by the provisions of this MOU expressed above in this English version.

PROGRAM AGREEMENT Jefferson at Brick Institute Design Program

Consistent with the terms of the MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the "MOU") entered into by and between Satish Misal Educational Foundation's Brick Group of Institutes ("Brick") and Thomas Jefferson University ("Jefferson") effective March 1, 2023, Brick and Jefferson developed the Jefferson at Brick Institute Design Program (the "Program") and enter into this agreement ("Program Agreement") to establish the terms for the Program. Brick and Jefferson may be referred to individually as Party and jointly as Parties.

1. Program.

- LI General. The Parties have developed an opportunity for students to earn a Master of Science (MS) degree in Sustainable Design from Jefferson in two (2) years. Interested students shall apply to Jefferson's College of Architecture and the Built Environment (the "CABE") to be accepted into the Program. Students shall be required to satisfy all Jefferson and CABE admission requirements. Brick will establish a process to perform an initial review of candidates and provide CABE with a list of interested and qualiffied students who intend to apply to the Program. CABE will review the applications and CABE shall select the students to be accepted into and enrolled in Program ("Program Students").
- 1.2 Course Work. Program Students shall take first year courses online and on campus at BRICK and shall take second year courses on campus at Jefferson. The required courses are set forth on Addendum A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein. In the event a Program Student is unable to be on-site at Jefferson, an alternative path for such Program Student to complete the degree online will be determined.
- 1.3 Program Students. Parties shall discuss and agree to the number of students to be enrolled into the Program each year. Parties agree that the number of Program Students per studio course section is a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of fifteen (15). If more than fifteen (15) Program Students are enrolled to take the course, a new section will need to be provided, e.g., the same course will be offered in more than one section.
- 1.4 Tuition. Program Students shall be considered Jefferson students and pay tuition for Program courses and fees, if applicable to Jefferson. Jefferson shall establish the cost of tuition and fees, which may include an application fee and taxes.
- 1.5 Degree. Students successfully completing the Program shall carn a MS degree from Jefferson. Parties acknowledge that this is not a joint or dual degree.
- 1.6 Brick Support. To support the Program, Brick shall provide the following:
 - Sufficient classroom on campus at Brick to accomodatethe section(s) of the studio course to be conducted at Brick as described in Addendum A.
 - b. Brick faculty to provide instruction for the Program's studio course to be conducted at Brick as described in Addendum A. The Parties agree that Brick shall identify interested and qualified faculty and Jefferson shall select the faculty to teach the studio course and other Program courses. Qualifications for the faculty shall

or termination, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration under the Rules of Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce ("ICC"), which Rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference into this clause. The number of arbitrators shall be one. The arbitrator shall be agreed between the parties. Failing agreement, or if the arbitrator selected is unable or is unwilling to act, the appointing authority shall be the ICC. The cost of Arbitration shall be divided equally among the Parties, but with each Party bearing its own legal costs, if any. The seat, or legal place, of arbitration shall be Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. USA. The Parties agree to conduct any hearing remotely or by other appropriate means of communication. The language to be used in the arbitral proceedings shall be English. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding upon both parties and shall be enforceable in any court of law pursuant to The New York Arbitration Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards. Each of the parties waives irrevocably their right to any form of appeal, review or recourse to any state court or other judicial authority, insofar as such waiver may be validly made.

11. MOU.

The terms of the applicable MOUbetween the Parties including the definitions set forth therein shall apply to the Program and the terms of this Program Agreement. In the event of conflict between the terms of the MOU and this Program Agreement, the Program Agreement shall control.






