The Meeting of the Fees Regulating Authority (constituted under section 11(2)(3)(4) of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 held on **17th August 2022** in the Conference Hall, Room No. 305, Government Polytechnic Building, 49 Kherwadi, Ali Yawar Jung Marg, Bandra (E), Mumbai - 400 051.

Item No.1: To discuss the guidelines issued by the AICTE dated 16/5/2022 for the determination of fees in respect of Technical courses.

"Discussed.

It was decided to implement the guidelines issued by the National Fee Committee in respect of Technical courses to the extent in consonance with the existing provisions of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015.

Item No.2: To discuss and decide the Ad-hoc fee to be charged in respect of new courses started by the Institute from the academic year 2022-2023.

A) Higher and Technical Courses

"Discussed.

After taking into consideration the Ad-hoc fee declared for the academic year 2021-2022, the fees of the various courses run by the Unaided Educational Institutions finalized by the Authority for the academic year 2021-2022 and the guidelines issued by the National Fee Committee in respect of the Technical Courses, it was decided to declare the Ad-hoc fees of Higher and Technical courses newly started by the Unaided Educational Institutions from the academic year 2022-2023 as under:

C) Agriculture Courses

After taking into consideration the Ad-hoc fee declared for the academic year 2021-2022, the fees of the various courses run by the Unaided Educational Institutions finalized by the Authority for the academic year 2021-2022, it was decided to declare the Ad-hoc fees of Agriculture Courses newly started by the Unaided Educational Institutions from the academic year 2022-2023 as under:

Note:

1. The Adhoc fees as declared above shall be applicable to respective new courses started by the Unaided Institutions from the academic year 2022-2023.
2. The Ad-hoc fees to be charged to students admitted in the academic year 2022-2023 by the newly started courses/colleges shall be maximum fees to be charged by the Institutions .
3. The Adhoc fees to be charged to students subject to finalization of fees by the Fees Regulating Authority in respect of such course.
4. If the fees determined and finally approved by the Authority found to be less than the Adhoc fees charged and collected by the Institute then the difference in amount of fees to be refunded to such students by the Institute.
5. If the fees determined and finally approved by the Authority found to be more than the Adhoc fees charged and collected from the students then the Institute will be entitled to claim the difference in the amount

from such students subject to such order to be passed by the Authority.

6. The Institution shall be under obligation to submit the online proposal with requisite documents as provided u/s. 14(1)(a) of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015, to approve the fees charged as Adhoc fees and further to approve the fees for the academic year 2023-2024 or 2024-2025 as the case may be.
7. No Institution shall charge the fees in any form over and above the Adhoc fees declared by the Fees Regulating Authority".

Item No.3: To discuss and decide the minimum fees (De-minimis) for various courses for the academic year 2022-2023.


