Dr. Vasudha A Gokhale (B.Arch - MANIT, Bhopal, M.Arch and PhD from IIT Roorkee) is a Professor and Head of PhD Research Centre at B.N. College of Architecture Pune.

**Dr. Abhijeet Natu** – Dr. Abhijeet Natu graduated from the BKPS College of Architecture, Pune in 1992. He completed his Masters in Landscape Architecture from SPA Delhi. His research interests include environment behaviour, landscape architecture and architectural conservation. He is presently the Chairman Board of Studies in Architecture at the Savitribai Phule Pune University. He is associated with BKPS Pune as a professor.

**Aim of the workshop:** To understand the process of writing a research paper and how to choose the right journal for writing various types of research papers

#### The workshop is proposed into two phases

1. **Pre-workshop exercise** upon writing abstracts to prepare faculties to be ready with their abstracts
2. **Actual one day workshop** - Inputs and discussions by the experts upon understanding various types of research papers and methodologies opted for same. Knowing technical writing and various journals to publish research papers.

#### Objectives to be covered:

1. Input upon developing ideas about Types of research papers written in the field of architecture and methodologies opted for various research
2. Writing a research paper and what is technical writing
3. Advice upon identification of Journals to publish the paper

**Target audience/ Participants:** Faculty of the SMEF'S Brick school of Architecture, Pune

**Brief about the workshop:** Workshop would be conducted in two parts details are as below

- 1) **Pre-workshop exercise** - Small exercise of abstract writing would be conducted by research head Dr. Vaidehi Lavand helping in knowing how different ways could be explored in writing abstracts. The basic framework of an abstract, contents of abstract, different types of papers such as descriptive, statistical, review papers, etc., and discussion upon how the contents in abstract are changing in each type of paper. With



this exercise, faculties would be ready with the abstracts of their interest areas that would be discussed with the experts for the actual workshop.

## 2) Brief about one-day workshop

The focus of the workshop is to have methodic discourse upon the process of writing a research paper. Being in the academic field faculty of the architecture needs extra support to understand the technicalities of writing research papers for various types of research papers in the field of Architectural education and practice. The discussion will begin with types of research papers and methods opted in architectural research. Discussion upon various aspects of Methodologies and Methods of research in Architecture for different types of research papers. This will continue with input upon technical writing for a research paper.

Discussions on Ph.D. synopsis/proposals and abstracts written by the faculty will help to get more specific comments about the writings and ideas about the research proposals.
